


ART SEEK-AND-FIND INSTRUCTIONS

1 FAITH FAMILY FOOD by Such Styles and Champ Styles | Spray paint

A colorful ode to 100 years of comida delicioso! A shortcut north through the beautiful Vision Gallery courtyard will lead you to this celebration of a Chandler institution.

2. WINGED VICTORY (SAULE SQUAD) by Pete Goldlust/Melanie Germond Water-jet cut aluminum, automotive paint

Tall and colorful, this temporary piece commissioned by INFLUX (a valley-wide public art collaboration) features a few ancient Baltic symbols. *How many can you spot?*

①: ancient Baltic symbol for Sun

x: The cross of Dievs. World order. Dynamism, productivity, movement, development. The ideal balance between the old and new, the past and present.

3 VICTOR HUGO by Geoffrey Gross* | Wood, steel, stone

Fine arts and gunsmithing skills lent aid to creating this piece. How does this sculpture make you feel? Why do you think it is named Victor Hugo?

- DR. AJ CHANDLER AND FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT by Igor Zorkin* | Bronze
 - Two Jazz-age visionaries, an unlikely friendship and a whole lot of desert. Some long-time Chandlerites can remember Mr. Wright exiting the train from St. Louis with his apprentices and his iconic cape.
- C-NOTE by Kevin Caron* | Iron
 - Cross the street and find this unique and noisey sculpture. Wiggle the gong and see if you can hear the beginning of Do-Re-Mi! Ignore the plague- this sculpture is all song and no dance!
- 6. THE ROSALES FAMILY PIONEERING PROJECT by Emanuel Martinez* | Bronze

Look across at the beautiful San Marcos Hotel. In 1911, Augustin Rosales started his legacy by clearing mesquite trees from the land that the hotel now sits on. *How many generations has your family lived in Chandler? Arizona?*

7. SAN TAN BREWERY MURAL by Such Styles and Champ Styles* | Spray paint

Head down the alley to get a look at a nod to the desert and its inhabitants' love of all things brewery! Check out the backs of the buildings as you walk south to catch some historic vibes.

CUBIZM by Jeff Zischke* | Powder-coated steel and tile on concrete

A bench, a sculpture, landmark. But also, a secret message? Rumor has it you can find it if you know morse code. If you decode it, let us know!

MONUMENTS TO US by Joey Salamon and Cam DeCaussin* | Paint

Say hello to the newest piece in our city's collection! Take a walk from modern to historic and feel how we are really connected to our Chandler roots. What is the oldest building in Chandler you've been in?

5 C'S by Joe Tyler* | Welded steel, mixed materials
