

Vision Kids Policies - Virtual Classes 2020

Vision Gallery hosts Vision Kids, is a series of art classes taught by professional artists for kids ages six to sixteen, offered free of charge. Our students come from all areas of the Valley and represent a wide array of diverse backgrounds; anyone can participate! Our students learn techniques in a variety of media including drawing, watercolor, ceramics, photography, and more! Vision Kids is designed to inspire children's creativity and empower them to integrate art into their daily lives.

Vision Kids is made possible through the support of the Chandler Cultural Foundation, a 501(c)3 organization. Your generous donations help to make visual and performance arts accessible to our Chandler community and beyond.

Class Format

- Classes are held on Saturdays via Zoom at 10am and 1pm, and are two hours long.
- Our virtual classroom will be locked 10 minutes after the class start time to ensure the class's safety. Please make sure to join the Zoom meeting on time or call us if you will be late.
- Vision Gallery staff may record video of the instructor leading the virtual class. We will never record the Zoom screen, including images of your children. If you would like, we encourage you to email us your photos of your child taking the class – these may be used for Vision Kids marketing

Registration and Supplies

- Registration will take place online via Eventbrite; go to <u>visiongallery.org/vision-kids</u> to view the schedule of classes and links to register. Registration opens Saturday, August 15, 2020 at 10am.
- There is a registration limit of three classes per child, per semester. Registration is first-come, first-serve, and remains open until all classes are full. There is a limit of 35 students per virtual class.
- We keep a waitlist for all of our classes. If a class is full, it never hurts to put your name on the list!
- When you are registering, you will be asked if you would like to supply all your own materials for the class, pick up some materials supplied by Vision Gallery, or if you need assistance with all of the supplies. There is a limit of 20 partial supply kits and 5 complete supply kits for each morning and afternoon class. Each event page has complete information about the supplies needed.
- Supply kits for those who reserve them will be available for pick-up at Vision Gallery during our business hours beginning the Saturday before the class.

Cancellation and No-Show Policy

- We will email a reminder for the class the day before; it is your responsibility to call or email us to cancel your registration if your family will not be able to attend. Please contact us as soon as you know that you must cancel so that we can attempt to fill your spot in the class.
- These classes are very popular, and registration goes quickly. We want to fill each class to capacity so
 that as many kids as possible can participate. Therefore, participants who do not show up for the class
 and make no attempt to contact us will be removed from future classes. To avoid this, please review
 the class schedule carefully before registering and cancel your reservation as soon as you know your
 family will no longer be attending. If something comes up at the last minute, please let us know.
