Request for Qualifications

Traffic Control Box vinyl wraps

Deadline – Sunday, August 8, 2021, 11:59 p.m. Mountain Standard Time

Description

The City of Chandler is looking for 16 Arizona-based artists or artist teams to create digital artwork that will be printed and installed on metal traffic control cabinets in Uptown Chandler and near Hamilton high school. Chosen designs will reflect the character of the area. While the City is primarily seeking digital illustrations, original work by photographers, painters, drawers and printmakers will also be considered.

Select artists or artist teams for 5 of the boxes will work with a student or students from Hamilton high school to come up with a concept, which the artist will interpret and hone into a finished design. The other 11 boxes will be designed without additional student input, but will still be subject to approval by the city.

Cabinet locations and dimensions are on the following pages. Artwork should be designed to fully cover all faces of the cabinets and will be installed using vinyl adhesive wraps. Selected artists will be paid a stipend of \$1,000 per box, which will cover all design costs. Production and installation costs will be covered by the City.

Qualification submissions are due by 11:59 p.m. on August 8, 2021, and can be submitted digitally via the webform found here: <https://forms.gle/Q45Z4KHxHQ86XuLr8>

Submission Criteria – All entries must include:

1. Current contact information, including email and phone number
2. Artist/Artist team members’ biographical information. If available, submit a current resume or curriculum vitae (CV) including artist(s) accomplishments. Resume or CV should not exceed 2 pages per artist team member. If a resume is not available or does not accurately represent your qualifications, please submit a list of your artistic accomplishments. Please note, no previous public art experience is required to participate in this opportunity.
3. Digital Images: Up to 5 images can be submitted per team and should include past completed projects. Artists may also include a proposed original design for this project, however it is not required in this first stage. All images should be included in the .pdf file and be 2000 – 3000 pixels in the longest direction. A corresponding image list with all pertinent information is also required. Image list should include size, date completed, and materials used.
4. An introduction not to exceed 500 words explaining your previous completed projects (if applicable) and any inspirations you will draw on for this project. Please also note if you would prefer to work with a student on a design, or you would prefer to work alone.

Selection Process and Schedule

All artist submissions will be reviewed by the City of Chandler Arts Commission. All entries must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on August 8, 2021. The City anticipates selecting 16 artists/artist teams for this project. The timeline for this RFQ is as follows:

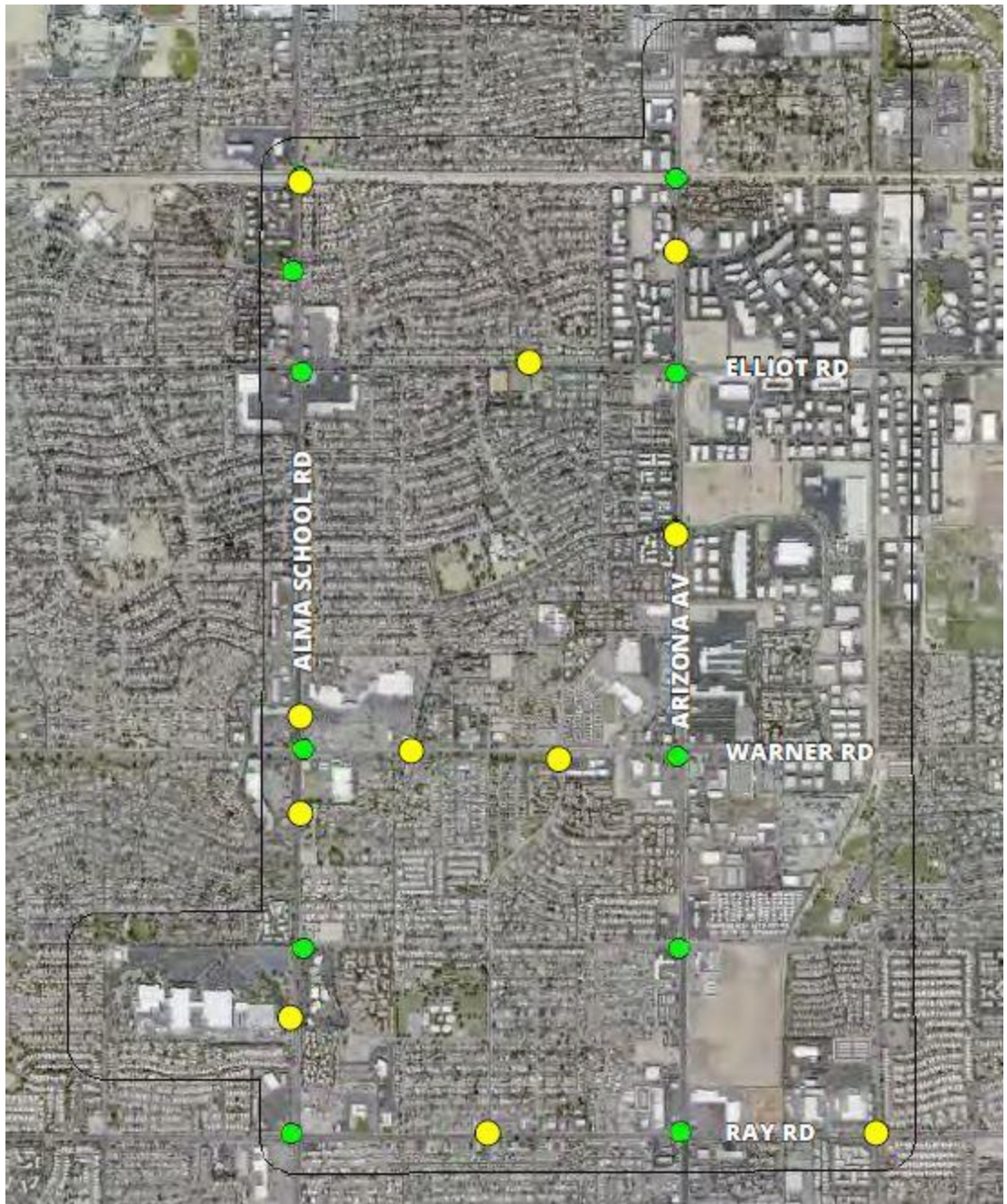

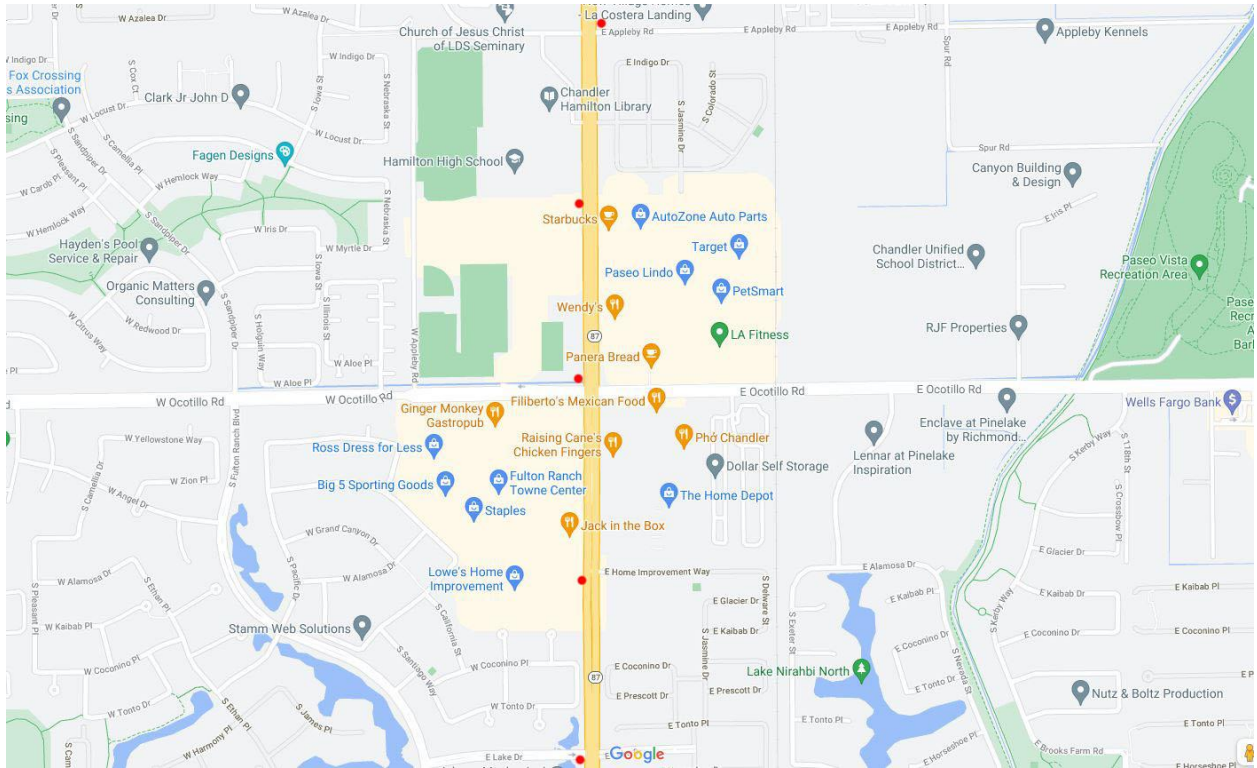
