At the beginning of the pandemic, the landscape of our daily lives went through a dramatic shift. Most of us spent substantially more time in our homes. The spaces that were once a refuge from our public lives became home offices, restaurants, movie theaters, and childcare centers. While Chelsie Tamala's work gives an intimate glimpse into people's domestic interior lives, Cam DeCaussin's paintings depict eerily vacant or solitary exteriors, echoing the isolation and loneliness of that time. In both artists' paintings, viewers can sense the stillness and introspection many felt during this time of great change, which still echoes through our lives today.

## MAKE YOUR OWN

Make your own house out of cardboard! This can be a model of your real house, your dream house, or even a castle! Customize it however you like! Follow the steps below or scan the QR code for more detailed instructions.

- 1. Cut out the front and back walls of your house from a piece of cardboard
- 2. On the front wall of the house, cut out a door
- 3. Cut out the other two walls of your house, then cut some holes into the sides to create windows
- 4. Now that you have 4 walls, glue them together to create the basic structure of the house
- 5. Grab another bigger piece of cardboard to act as your floor. Glue your 4 walls on top of the floor.
- 6. Fold a piece of cardboard in half to make a triangle-shaped roof and glue it on top of your 4 walls.
- 7. Glue small pieces of cardboard around your house to create a fence
- 8. Customize it anyway you like! Add a walkway, paint the house, make popsicle stick people who live in the house, whatever you want!
