Vision Kids Policies – Spring Season 2026

Class Format

- Classes are held on Saturdays at Vision Gallery at 10am and 1pm and are two hours long
- Students who arrive 10 minutes or more after the class start time will not be admitted.
- Unless your family has an emergency, please plan to stay for the duration of the class. It is disruptive when students leave early.
- Parents and guardians are no longer required to stay during the class. Given they have completed a release form for us to keep on file for your child: <https://forms.gle/qLX9rdh9KwRvgnYz9>

Class Calendar

- Classes run from August to June and will be announced for the Fall/Winter and Spring/Summer sessions and be released for registration roughly every 6 weeks.
- Spring/ Summer classes of 2026, running from January to June, will be announced on November 15th 2025 with registration releases on November 22nd, January 10th, and March 7th.

Registration and Supplies

- Registration will take place online via Eventbrite; go to visiongallery.org/vision-kids to view the schedule of classes and links to register.
- Registration is first-come, first-serve, and remains open until all classes are full. There is a limit of 20 students per class.
- Families may register for one class per release, a maximum of three classes per season. If you register your child for more than three classes in a semester we will contact you to choose which classes to keep. If we are unable to reach you, we may adjust your reservations for you.
- We keep a waitlist for all of our classes. If a class is full, it never hurts to put your name on the list! If you are able to attend a class because of a waitlist, we will waive the 3-class rule.
- All materials will be supplied by Vision Gallery.

Cancellation and No-Show Policy

- You will receive a confirmation form via email the Saturday before each class. You will need to confirm your attendance using the confirmation form by 5pm on the Wednesday before each class you are registered for. If you do not confirm by that deadline, you may lose your reservation. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to manage your reservation and check your emails.
- Participants who do not show up for class and make no attempt to contact us may be removed from future classes. To avoid this, please review the class schedule carefully before registering and cancel your reservation as soon as you know your family will no longer be attending. If something comes up at the last minute, please let us know.
